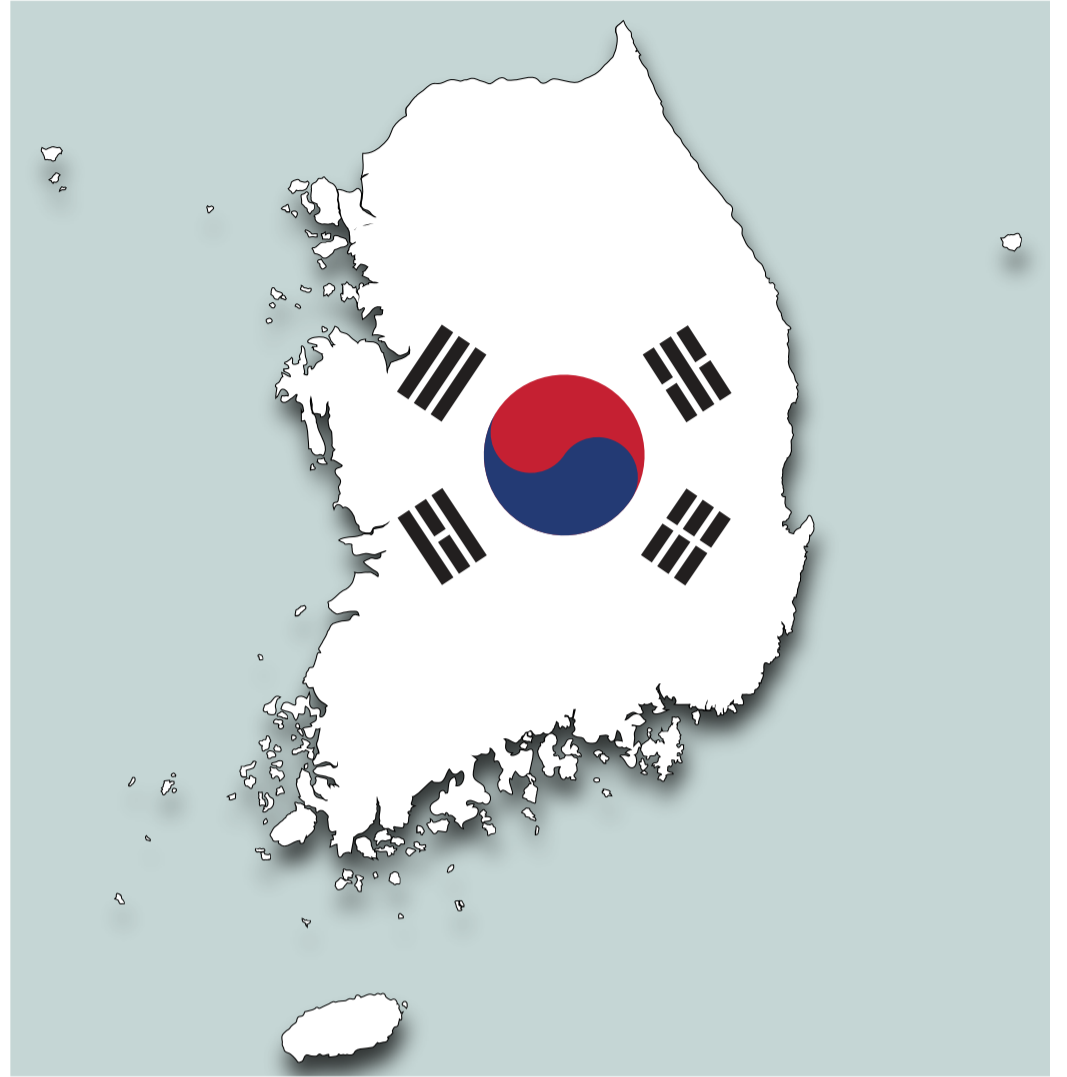


Archbishop Desmond Tutu Centre for War and Peace Studies
